DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The proposed project herein specified and described includes the following work:

This work shall consist of installing new manholes and making point repairs in the City's sanitary sewer system at various locations around the City. The project includes performing a majority of the City's rapid response sewer repairs through June 1, 2009, as well as the additional sanitary sewer repair work identified by the City. The work will also include pavement removal and restoration along with traffic control, and other items of restoration.

The City of Decatur's Department of Engineering and Infrastructure, Engineering Division will not release the Engineer's Estimate of Cost in advance of the scheduled time and date of the bid opening. Bid tabulations will be available on the City's web site at www.ci.decatu.r.il.us/citygovernment/engineering.htm under Contractor Project Bid Information after the award of a contract has been approved by the City of Decatur City Council.
6. All proposals must be accompanied by a BANK DRAFT, CASHIER'S CHECK, OR CERTIFIED CHECK made payable to Treasurer, Decatur, Illinois, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid, or BID BOND in the same amount.
7. Prior to award, the top three (3) bidders shall provide a copy of their Workers Compensation Experience Modifier or equivalent documentation for the current year and the previous two (2) years with explanation for any year's Experience Modifier that is not a credit.
8. The contractor shall at all times during the term of this Contract pay the applicable prevailing wage for Macon County for the month during which the work is performed, as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor.
9. Before the Contractor and any Subcontractor commences work, the Contractor and any Subcontractor shall have in place a written Substance Abuse Prevention Program for the prevention of substance abuse among its employees which meets or exceeds the requirements in P. A. 95-0635 or shall have a collective bargaining agreement in effect dealing with the subject matter of P. A. 95-0635.
